

85TH ANNUAL MEETING OF MEMBERS MINUTES

WASHINGTON ELECTRIC MEMBERSHIP CORP. OCTOBER 19, 2022

Welcome

A Special Meeting of Members of Washington Electric Membership Corp. was held Wednesday, October 19, 2022, at the Washington EMC headquarters in the city of Sandersville, Ga. The Board of Directors called this Special Meeting in lieu of the 85th Annual Meeting in accordance with Section 2.02 of the Bylaws, due to the closure of the meeting venue three days before the scheduled date of the 85th Annual Meeting of Members, which was Saturday, October 1, 2022. To facilitate member voting, and due to the limited availability of venues that could accommodate a large meeting on short notice, the meeting was held at the headquarters using a walk-thru format.

Credential and Election Committee

The Credential and Election Committee, consisting of the following members, Edward Burten, Bruce Morgan, Jim Jackson, Wendy Purvis, Donna Snell, Charles Young and Viola Warren, was present for the entire duration of the Annual Meeting and tabulated all ballots after the closure of the meeting.

Quorum

There were a total of 1,119 registered members, which constituted a quorum in accordance with Section 2.06 of the Bylaws. A copy of the Credential and Election Committee's Election Certification and its Certification of the Existence of a Quorum are both attached.

Approval of minutes

A copy of the 2021 Annual Meeting Minutes were included in the 2022 Official Notice that was mailed to each member. Members were given a ballot to vote for the minutes once they registered. The minutes were approved by the members in attendance. A copy of the Credential and Election Committee's Certification on the Approval of the 2021 Annual Meeting Minutes is attached.

Proposed Washington EMC Bylaw Changes

A copy of the proposed Washington EMC Bylaw changes was included in the 2022 Official Notice that was mailed to each member. Once members registered, they were given a ballot to vote for the proposed Washington EMC Bylaw changes. The proposed Washington EMC Bylaw changes were approved by members in attendance. A copy of the Committee's Certification on the Proposal to Change Bylaws is attached.

Election of directors

Also included in the 2022 Official Notice was a copy of Notice of Nominees for Director Elections: District 3, Brenda English (running unopposed); and District 4, William "Billy" T. Helton (incumbent) verses Rodney Shane Lord. A copy of a Special Meeting of Members Registration Card and Registration Affidavit were also included in the Official Notice. Members were given a ballot to vote for nominees for director, once they registered. Director English, District 3, and Director Helton, District 4, were each elected to serve for another three-year term by a majority vote. A copy of the Credential and Election Committee's Certification of the District 3 and 4 elections are attached.
